This year was challenging yet rewarding for Cornerstone Pregnancy Services and many pro-life partners and ministries. Our amazing God continued to strengthen and keep us as He poured out His grace, mercy, and protection. We have finished this fiscal year with such victory and promise, we can only look forward with great expectations for the forthcoming months and years. On June 24, 2022, in a 5-4 decision, Roe was overturned leading us into new territory we have never been before. However, it is a time in which we have prayed fervently and fought hard to win. We are exhilarated to continue ministering with compassion and providing essential services to women and men facing unplanned pregnancies. As we move ahead, it is important to prepare to serve more complex clients by offering more comprehensive medical services and inspiring programs empowering them to choose a path leading to life.

Though our hearts rejoiced as we entered this new era in the fight for the unborn, we understand our battle now takes on a new dimension. Nonetheless, with endurance, patience, and trust in the Lord, we will again experience victory. Endurance means to continue the road we trod, though it may become bumpy or develop twists or turns along the way. Ultimately the path becomes clear, and the road levels out, and we reap the rewards of remaining faithful under adversity. In Hebrews 10:36, the scriptures reveal the reward we receive when we persevere for righteousness, explicitly the satisfaction that we have done the will of God and rescue from His hand. "For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. But the one who endures to the end will be saved." Our reward, prayerfully, is an abortion-free America where hearts are revived and turned to embrace the sanctity of life, recognizing the humanity and value of life in the womb. We must continue with the same passion and fervency we possessed prior to the Dobbs decision. God's resolve to remove the altars of child sacrifice from our land and to reestablish the biblical framework of the sanctity of human life is the heartbeat of this battle. With our focus set on our mission during the 2021-2022 fiscal year, we served 265 clients, 64 of these clients were abortion-minded, and we provided a total of 953 client visits for medical care and program services. The Gospel is an integral part of our ministry; we realize that it is the power of the gospel that changes the hearts and the minds of those we serve. Our staff and client advocates dedicated time sharing the gospel with 137 clients and performed spiritual discussions with 171 clients who asked questions related to their relationship with God. Twenty-four clients made a new profession of faith and three renewed their commitment to follow Jesus Christ.

As we move into a new and exciting year of ministry, we will offer post-abortion assessments creating an opportunity to bring healing to post-abortive women and men. We will collaborate with local health partners to implement programs to assess pregnant women with early identification of life-threatening health risks and provide timely medical referrals with our advanced practice nurses. Our nurses will focus on providing more appointments for ultrasound clients, focusing on earlier intervention for abortion-prone women. Our participation with local health agencies, like Lorain County Public Health Department and local hospitals, will help to reduce maternal mortality by screening our clients eligible for doula support which has been shown to improve maternal outcomes.

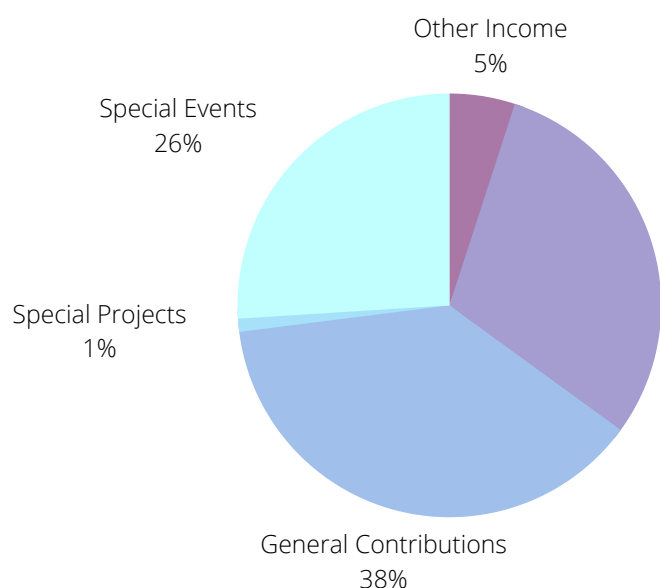

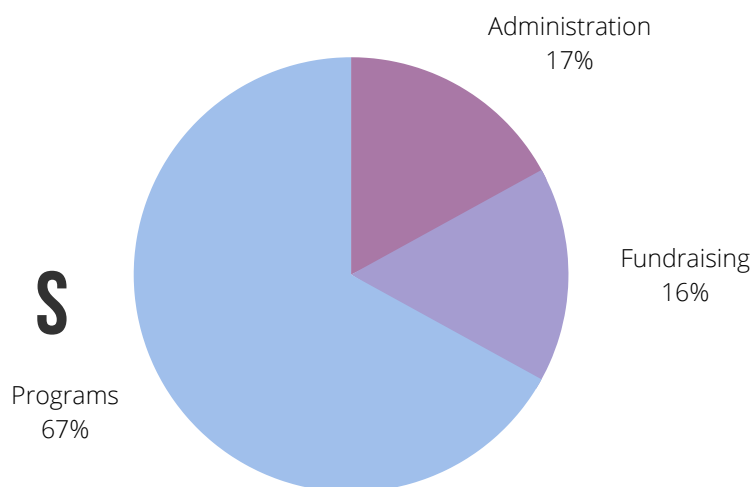
