FROM THE DESK OF THE CEO

2025 Impact Update

DEAR CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE,

In 2025, we had the opportunity to meet women right where they are—at the crossroads of life-changing decisions. Across our medical clinics in Elyria and Cleveland, we served more than seven hundred clients. In our prenatal clinic in Elyria, we also served sixteen women who were at elevated risk for addiction, and 50% of these clients were initially abortion-determined. By God’s grace and through compassionate care, 75% of these women ultimately made life-affirming decisions.

As we reflect on 2025, we are grateful for the unwavering commitment and generosity that sustains Cornerstone Pregnancy Services. This past year was one of profound impact, hope, and growth as we walked alongside women and men facing unexpected pregnancies and life-altering decisions. Across our two medical clinics, we administered 496 pregnancy tests, provided 488 ultrasounds, and performed 51 STD tests.

Impact Highlights

Every client who entered our doors brought a unique story—often marked by uncertainty, fear, and vulnerability. Through compassionate care and practical support, our team and volunteers served as a steady presence of hope and dignity. Because of your support, we provided 3,142 client visits through ultrasounds, parenting classes, doula visits, case-management follow-up, and the distribution of material assistance. Each touchpoint offered individuals the resources and confidence they needed to choose life and embrace their futures.

Beyond the Clinic

This year, we strengthened our programs, so clients receive not only immediate assistance but also long-term support through parenting education, mentorship, and community referrals. These accomplishments would not be possible without our resolute staff and volunteers, whose compassion and professionalism reflect the values and mission of Cornerstone Pregnancy Services. I am also deeply touched by our donors, church partners, and community collaborators whose faithful support emboldens us to extend the love of Christ when it is needed most.

Looking Ahead to 2026

As we look ahead to 2026, we remain committed to expanding our outreach, enhancing our medical services, and standing unified as a beacon of life in the communities God has entrusted to us. While the cultural and social landscape becomes more antithetical towards life, our mission remains steadfast: to empower individuals to choose life and to support families with grace and integrity.

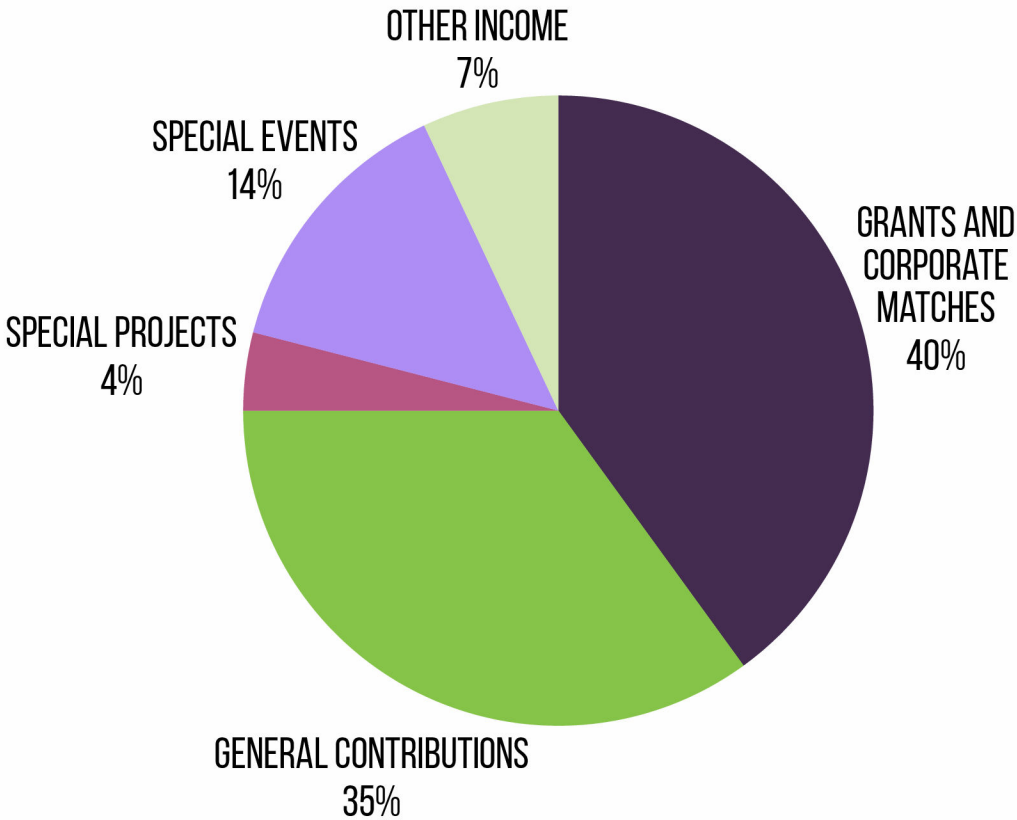

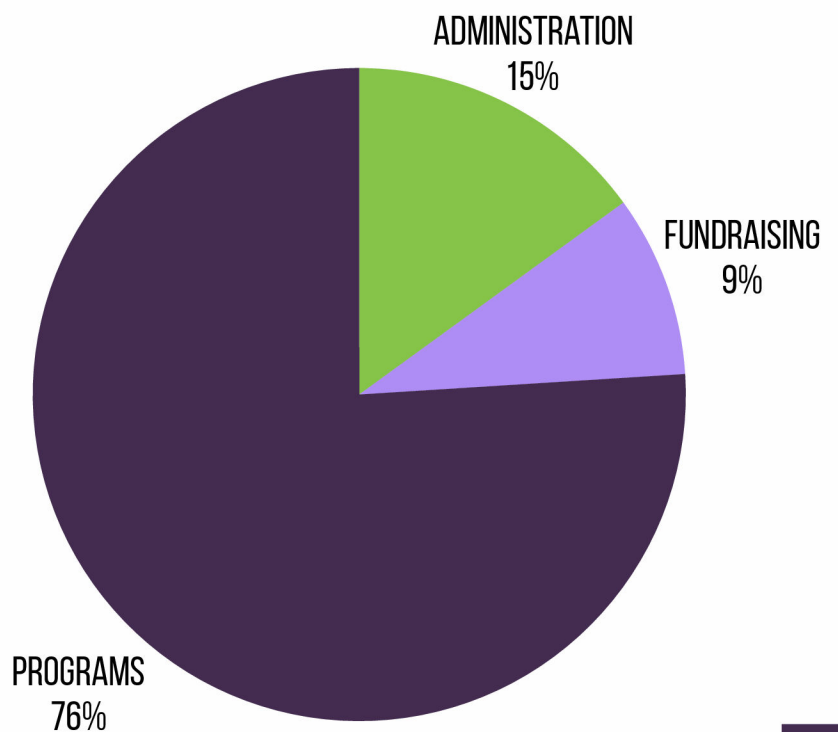

Cornerstone Women’s Health Center Fiscal Year Report

Cornerstone Women’s Health Center partnered with Dr. Beeman and Veranova Health through a grant from the Ohio Department of Behavioral Health to provide prenatal care for women who are at risk or struggling with addiction. The prenatal clinic started on March 26, 2025, and during this fiscal year period, 16 women received prenatal care. At intake, 5 were abortion-minded, 3 were undecided, and 9 intended to parent. Ultimately, 6 women changed their decision to parent, and as of June 30, 2025, seven babies had been born. That translate into 50% of these patients had abortion as an option, and 75% chose life! We are looking forward to see how this program continues to change lives as more women chose life!

One patient testimony highlights the impact of this program. The patient initially presented as undecided and received an ultrasound to confirm a viable pregnancy, followed by a second ultrasound one week later. Although she remained uncertain, she scheduled an appointment with Dr. Beeman and later chose to parent. She was referred to the Community Health Worker (CHW) for support, including employment and medical insurance resources. The patient continued working with the CHW, began LEU classes, and successfully gave birth. She remains connected to CHW support in the postpartum period.

Lilli Women’s Center Report

Lilli Women’s Center has begun a remarkable phase of transformation.

Through this year of joining forces with Cornerstone Pregnancy Services, Lilli Women’s Center continued to serve the clients of Cuyahoga County with professionalism, compassion, and prayer. 353 new clients came through our doors covered in the prayers of our staff, volunteers and prayer team. 317 clients came in Abortion Vulnerable and received pregnancy tests, 231 received sonograms and all of them were given a listening ear and clear, accurate options.

The year ended with a total renovation of the Lilli Boutique with the help of the Knights of Columbus and some great volunteers. Our clients are so impressed with the upscale look and the great selection of items to purchase with their parenting class earnings.

The Education and Support Services Department

The Education and Support Services Department serves clients through Brightcourse videos, System Training for Effective Parenting (STEP) classes, doula services, resources through our Community Healthcare Worker (CHW), and sharing the love of Jesus Christ. Total program participation included 2,153 client visits. Each and every visit is an opportunity to support the client and give them hope.

Cornerstone enrolled 72 new clients through our Life Ed “U” intakes process. The clients participated in 2,075 online video classes and as a result, earned \$64,428 Baby Bucks and \$2,224 Dads Dollars to purchase new items in the Baby Boutique. The current pre/post test score is 29.44% and the classes include topics related to pregnancy, childbirth, baby’s first year, toddler years, parenting, and coparenting. We also offer coursework that addresses life skills, love lessons, special circumstances, fatherhood lessons, and Bible studies.

The Doula Program provides clients with education and personal care during pregnancy, childbirth, and postpartum. Cornerstone doulas provided 131 services including assessments, pregnancy and nutrition education, breastfeeding guidance, childbirth education, postpartum education, birth attendance, and postpartum care.

Cornerstone’s CHW completed 1,063 client touchpoints and provided hope along with much-needed resources during very stressful times. Throughout these visits, the CHW not only provides resources, but she also listens, comforts, prays, encourages, and even laughs with the clients. All of which they are very grateful.

Cornerstone also supported 69 families with emergency baby supplies. We appreciate the donor support which helps us serve each client and proclaim the truth.

Just this past year, 108 volunteers/groups logged a total of 3234.55 hours!

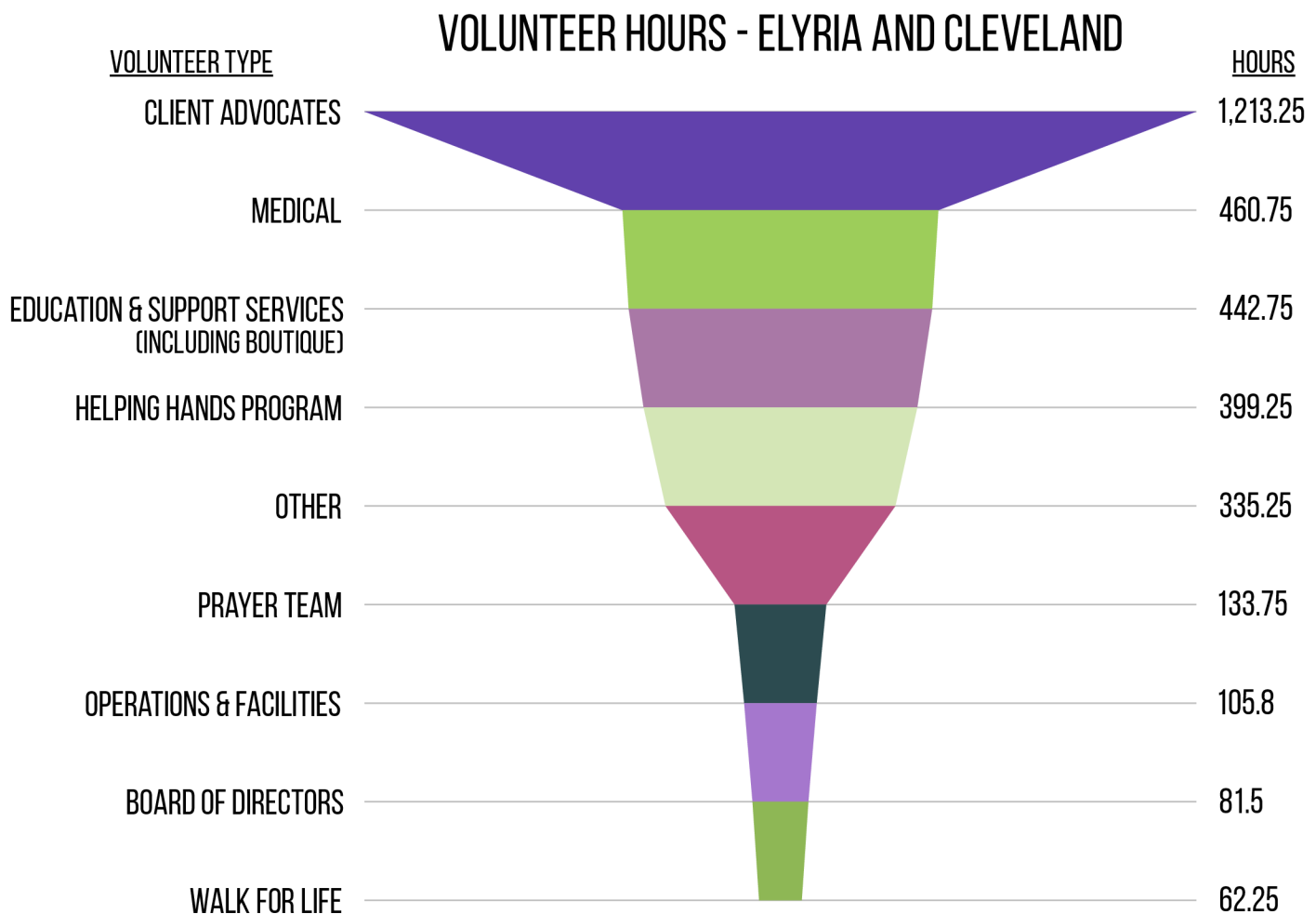
